### GENERAL

**Date: 28 April 2010**

Crow Global Inc. (CGI) is pleased to announce that we will be conducting a one day Tactical Pistol & Carbine Range Day (CGI\_TPCRD\_002) on Thursday 20 May 2010, at the Sharon Gun Club 45 minutes north of Toronto.

Due to limited available positions, it will be a first come bases for invited personnel only. The fee of **\$400.00** per person will be charged to all participants. There will be a maximum of 12 participants attending the CGI\_TPCRD\_002, by exclusive invite only from the following Agency:

- Canadian Military (Regular / Reserve);
- Police/ Law Enforcement;
- Armed Security Professionals.

### COURSE DETAILS

#### **TPCRD 002 AIM:**

This is an intense one day range day that is designed to review the candidate's weapons handling skills to the level that will be required in a fight. To increase the candidates understanding of their balance between speed and accuracy, efficiency in weapons handling, understanding of what the body's natural reactions are in a fight and competency with a handgun. These goals will be achieved through the use of reality based training methods and unique shooting drills. No matter your prior shooting experience beginner to expert. TPCRD is one of the best opportunities to refresh and build tactical shooting skills. A variety of drills and scenarios will be used to force the candidates to confront problems that occur during administrative weapons handling and to reinforce good habits.

The ultimate goal of our range day is to make our candidates as efficient as possible in the context of a fight for their lives, or the lives of others. We strongly believe in the evolution of training. To that end, our instructors are constantly evaluating the effectiveness of the training via the study of actual combat engagements as well as course feedback. Through consistent review we are able to bring our candidates the most relevant training available today.

**SCOPE OF TRAINING**

The scope of training will include both theory and practical range lessons on the following subjects:

- a. Review of weapons safety, marksmanship theory and characteristics;
- b. Review of Safety, Comfort and Competency;
- c. Review of The body's natural reactions to a threat;
- d. Review of Working efficiently with what the body does naturally;
- e. Review of Recognition;
- f. Review of Strong and support handed shooting;
- g. Review of Strong and support handed malfunctions;
- h. Review of Barricades / use of cover and concealment;
- i. Review of Shooting on the move;
- j. Presentation from the holster in 360 degrees;
- k. Review of Close Quarter Shooting;
- l. Reinforcement Drills;
- m. Open shoot / Practice personal drills/ Varying distances;
- n. Closing remarks/ Group Photo.

Many more topics will be covered than are listed here. This will be a dynamic range day designed to review candidates shooting techniques.

**Legal Notice:** All weapons and ammunition must be transported and stored in accordance with Canadian Government Law and regulations. Crow Global Inc will not be held liable for all issues pertaining to this matter.

### **Candidates Recommended Equipment (what to bring):**

The dress throughout will be appropriate range clothing. Appropriate clothing for seasonal inclement weather (hot, cold, rain or snow), Comfortable jeans or pants with cargo pockets, Water bottle or hydration system, , knit cap and brimmed hat, hiking or tactical boots, pants, sturdy belt, shooting gloves, tinted glasses, range bag, Eye glasses or contacts- if needed and Medicine- if needed.

Holster, Sturdy belt, magazine holders, Shooting Glasses, ear protection, Shooting Gloves, tinted glasses. CGI will provide required equipment upon request (price TBC).

### **CGI Will Provide the Following Equipment:**

Pistol, Three pistol magazines, Weapons cleaning kit, Multi tool. (If Required)

### **Certificates & Picture CD's:**

Upon successful completion of this range day candidates will receive a CGI certificate and a picture CD, which will be mailed out. Candidates are assessed throughout the training. Debriefs will be conducted with the candidates to highlight areas of improvement and tools to increase competency.

### **Prerequisites that must be completed PRIOR to beginning the Training Course:**

1. Military, police or other armed security professionals.
2. Due to the extensive nature of the training during this course, a photo ID will be required from all persons registering. CGI reserves the right to require any trainee to provide a police background check. Any persons with possible affiliation to a terrorist and or criminal organization need not apply. Persons who are convicted felons, have a documented history of mental illness, or have been convicted of domestic violence crimes (misdemeanor or felony) need not apply.
3. **Completion of the CGI Tactical Pistol Handling Course is recommended prior to attending this course.**
